1. Inner city problems have resulted from the decline of manufacturing industry. Describe two problems faced in these areas (8 lines, 4 marks).
2. Give two reasons for the decline of manufacturing industry in inner city areas (8 lines, 4 marks).
3. Choose an inner city area in an MEDC you have studied. Describe the efforts being made to redevelop or regenerate it (15 lines, 9 marks).
4. Describe the problems faced by motorists travelling into city centres (8 lines, 6 marks).
5. Describe the possible solutions to road traffic problems in urban areas. Refer to examples (12 lines, 6 marks).
6. Describe how changes in manufacturing industry can lead to loss of population and concentration of poverty in some inner city areas (10 lines, 5 marks).
7. Give **one** advantage of living in an inner city area (1 line, 1 mark).

8. A recent report on inner city areas described them as:

- Run down
- Polluted
- Congested
- Violent

Explain why each of the above may have occurred (4 lines each, 8 marks in total).

9. It is said that many city centre areas are in decline. Why do you think this is? (8 lines, 4 marks).
10. Give reasons why many people prefer to shop in out of town shopping centres. Refer to an example that you have studied.
