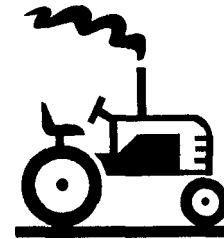


## Year 11 - Revision Questions - Food and Water Supplies

1. Give examples of how soil erosion can be reduced (7 lines, 5 marks).
2. Using an example you have studied, explain how desertification has led to famine in some LEDCs (7 lines, 4 marks).
3. For a named LEDC, describe ways in which:
  - EITHER food supply has been improved,
  - OR water supply has been improved. (10 lines, 6 marks).
4. For one of the improvements described above, describe the possible environmental damage it may cause (4 lines, 2 marks).
5. Suggest how malnourishment can lead to death in ways **other** than starvation alone (4 lines, 2 marks).
6. Ways which have helped some LEDCs to feed their populations are:
  - A Green Revolution
  - Population control
  - Food imports.
7. Describe the factors that may lead to soil erosion (8 lines, 4 marks).
8. Describe the methods which way be introduced by farmers to try to prevent soil erosion (8 lines, 4 marks).
9. Describe the role that international agencies can play in improving water and/or food supplies. Refer to **at least one** example that you have studied (12 lines, 6 marks).
10. Why does giving food aid not solve long-term food shortage problems for LEDCs? What could be done instead? (10 lines, 6 marks).
